




PXI Dual SPDT Microwave Switch with Internal Termination






Configured as a 5-Port DP3T Switch (With Both External Terminations Removed)


Remotely Mounted Microwave Relay Versions







Typical Insertion Loss - 18 GHz Versions




Typical Isolation - 18 GHz Versions







Typical Insertion Loss - 26.5 GHz Versions






Typical Insertion Loss - 40 GHz Internally Terminated Versions



Typical VSWR - 40 GHz Internally Terminated Versions




Typical VSWR - 40 GHz Externally Terminated Versions




