The 40-860A (PXI) and 42-860A (PXIe) are 2x2 insert/bypass MEMS fiber optic switches available in single, dual, triple or quad formats with a choice of different connector styles to suit most applications: FC/APC (for optimal performance), FC/PC and SC/PC for general applications and LC and MU for high density applications.

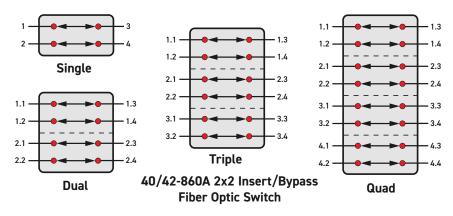


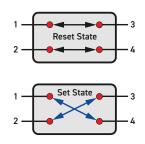

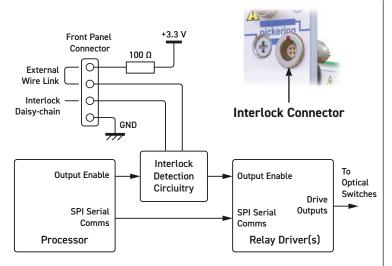
Switching Diagram of 2x2 Insert/ Bypass Fiber Optic Switch Showing Set & Reset States

Hardware Interlock

The 40/42-860A modules are available with an optional hardware interlock. The interlock, when activated, will return all optical switches to their default unpowered state (assuming the switches are fully functional) and also provide error notification via the software interface. The interlock feature can be daisy-chained between additional hardware interlock enabled modules for example to allow one signal to disable multiple cards. The hardware interlock feature is not available on 40/42-860A-4xx modules due to the size of the LC connectors.
